Frequently Asked Questions for Team Kim:

How much do you still need?

• We are 65% funded for our monthly needs, and fully funded for our initial moving and set-up costs.

When will you be going?

We will be allowed to move when we reach 100% of our funding. A team meeting is planned for February at Camino Global headquarters in Dallas, after which the first group of missionaries will be released to the field. We would love to be ready to go once the school year has ended. This allows us time to get legal paperwork in order, and helps our children with the various aspects of moving and transitioning into a new culture.

What will you be doing once you get to Colombia?

 For long-term success, our integration into Colombian culture is key. Our first year will be dedicated to strengthening our Spanish, navigating daily life in a new country, and building connections with local churches and ministries in Colombia. Through those connections, we will use graphic design and ESL for evangelism and discipleship in Colombia.
